

<b>Some Helpful TTY Abbreviations</b>	
<b>GA:</b>	<b>go ahead, your turn to talk</b>
<b>GA or SK:</b>	go ahead, or goodbye, or stop keying
<b>SKSK:</b>	stop keying, end of conversation
<b>U:</b>	you
<b>UR:</b>	your
<b>R:</b>	are
<b>TMW:</b>	tomorrow
<b>XXXX:</b>	error, erase
<b>ASAP:</b>	as soon as possible
<b>CD or CLD:</b>	could
<b>SHD:</b>	should
<b>HD or HLD:</b>	hold, please
<b>MSG:</b>	message
<b>NBR or NU:</b>	number
<b>PLS:</b>	please
<b>Q or QQ:</b>	question mark
<b>VCO:</b>	(voice carryover) TTY user will use his/her voice during call
<b>HCO:</b>	(hearing carryover) TTY user will use his/her hearing during call
<b>TTY:</b>	teletypewriter
